Enjoy guided sightseeing activities on the floodplains from dawn to dusk then immerse yourself in the luxury of this well-appointed wilderness camp. Accommodation comprises of nine private safari suites designed to blend into the surrounding bush. Each individual safari suite is en suite and raised on a timber platform to provide space for observing local wildlife.

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Day One – Thursday 25 June – Arrive Darwin

Transfer from Darwin Airport to the beautiful Mantra on the Esplanade for an afternoon at leisure prior to dining tonight in the friendly, ambient surrounds of the hotel's Finz Restaurant.

Day Two – Friday 26 June – Darwin to Bamurru Plains

Following a buffet breakfast, we depart by private air-conditioned coach on a scenic drive to Bamurru Plains, our wild bush luxury retreat on the edge of the Mary River floodplains. Enjoy lunch and a chance to relax in your private bungalow before an afternoon of wildlife viewing on the floodplains in an open top safari vehicle. You may see Agile Wallabies, Antilopine Wallaroos, Dingos, Estuarine Crocodiles and Water Buffalo. Enjoy our first dinner together in the Australian bush.

Day Three – Saturday 27 June – Bamurru Plains

Join us on an exhilarating early morning airboat tour on the wetlands of the Mary River catchment, home to thousands of Magpie Geese, Plumed Whistling-Ducks, Egrets, Ibis and a host of other birds. Return for lunch and an afternoon cruise on the Sampan River which harbours one of the largest crocodile populations in the world. You may also join an optional late afternoon bird watching tour or bush walk to learn more about Australia's 'bush tucker'.

Day Four – Sunday 28 June – Bamurru Plains to Darwin

Revisit the wetlands on an early morning airboat tour or simply relax in your luxurious bush camp before brunch and our late morning return by air-conditioned coach to our harbour view rooms at Darwin's Mantra on the Esplanade. Later today we transfer to Cullen Bay Marina for a sunset cruise and 'Tastes of the Top End' dinner onboard our privately-chartered luxury catamaran.

Day Five – Monday 22 June – Depart Darwin

This morning is yours to enjoy at leisure. Relax by the poolside or explore the city of Darwin from our hotel's central location. Join your fellow guests for a buffet lunch prior to your transfer to Darwin airport for your flight home.
